Frequently Asked Questions

Who is Sportsmagic?

Sportsmagic is a trusted provider of sportswear for athletics clubs across NSW. With Sportsmagic, ordering your uniform just got easier! Now you can browse, choose, and purchase directly [online](#).

Do I need a new uniform, or can I still wear my 2024/2025 season uniform?

Yes. You can continue wearing your 2024 season uniform. Previous uniform styles remain acceptable, so there's no need to purchase a new uniform if your current one still fits and is in good condition.

Do I need to wear a uniform on Friday nights?

Yes. Athletes must wear a Club uniform top (crop top, singlet or tee) displaying their membership number and black shorts on Friday nights.

If you need a new uniform before the season starts, visit [Sportsmagic](#). Please note the cut-off dates for guaranteed (and free!) delivery when placing an order.

Which uniform items do I need to purchase?

Athletes must wear either a Club singlet, tee or crop top. These can be purchased from our uniform supplier, [Sportsmagic](#). Athletes can wear any black shorts, tights or bike pants.

What is the Tiny Tots uniform?

Our youngest athletes wear the club tee. This can be purchased online through [Sportsmagic](#).

Is the Club tee only for Tiny Tot athletes?

No. Our new Club tee is available for all ages and can be worn to compete on Friday nights and at weekend competitions. The tee can be purchased online through [Sportsmagic](#).

How do I know which size to order from Sportsmagic?

We recommend you check out the size charts for each item on the [Sportsmagic](#) site. Most items are true to size. So, if your athlete normally wears a kids size 12 then we recommend you order the same size. Please note: the female racer back singlet is a tighter fit and the tee is a baggier fit so check out the size charts before ordering.

What is the cut-off date to receive my uniform for the first night of competition?

Sportsmagic will be selling uniforms at both of our registration days. Alternatively, if you place a uniform order [online](#) by 9am, Thursday 27 August you can collect it at our registration days.

At the beginning of the season, Sportsmagic offers free Club delivery. To receive your order for Friday night Club competition, orders should be placed before 9am.

- Order by 9am Tuesday 15 September and receive on Friday 18 September
- Additional date TBC in October

Order and pay any time before 9am on the above date and select 'Club Pick Up' to receive free delivery. Your order will be sent to the Club uniform shop and will be ready for collection from 5:30pm on the nominated Friday night.

If you order outside of the nominated dates, standard delivery charges will apply. Shipping will be calculated at the checkout.

How can I avoid paying a delivery charge?

Order before 9am on the following dates:

- Tuesday 15 September, receive on Friday 18 September
- Additional date TBC in October

Select 'Club Pick Up' and your order will be delivered to the Club free of charge. Your order will be ready for collection at the Club Uniform shop from 5.30pm on the nominated Friday night.

I have a competition on the weekend and just realised I don't have a uniform. How can I order one?

Visit the uniform page on the Club website and click the **order uniform** button. If you have missed the free club delivery dates offered by Sportsmagic, you will need the uniform sent directly to you and pay a delivery charge. Alternatively, you can pick up your order from Sportsmagic who are located at Chipping Norton.

I missed the free delivery window. How much is the delivery charge?

This can vary as Sportsmagic calculates the standard delivery charge at checkout.

Where do I place my age patch and membership number?



Can the age patch and membership number be ironed on?

No. These important patches need to be sewn or pinned on.

My child has lost their patches. What should I do?

Please contact our Registrar to organise replacements. A \$10 replacement fee applies.

What footwear should athletes wear?

Running shoes are great for athletics, especially for our younger athletes. Waffles are optional. Spikes can be worn and start from the 11s age group.

Can my child wear spikes?

Yes, spikes can be worn from the 11s age group.

Athletes in 11s and 12s age groups can wear spikes in laned events (100m, 200m and 400m) and jump events (long jump and high jump). Athletes in the 13s age group and above can wear spikes for all events.

Does the uniform shop sell spikes?

Yes. We sell second-hand, pre-loved spikes in the Club Uniform shop. We also accept second-hand spikes in good condition as donations.

I hear it gets cold at Greenway Oval on Friday nights. What can my child wear to stay warm?

At the beginning of the season, especially September to November, the temperature can drop at night on Greenway Oval. Athletes (and parents!) should bring something warm to wear over their Club competition tops.

Alternatively, you can purchase a Cherrybrook Club hoodie from [Sportsmagic](#).
